The Spring 2008 IEEE-Tech/IAC Golf Tournament is nearing. The tournament will begin at **12:00 noon** on **Wednesday, April 16<sup>th</sup>** in a shotgun start formation. We will be playing at **Brairecrest Country Club** this year, located at 1929 Country Club Drive, in Bryan (please refer to the attached map for further directions). Registration opens at **11:30am**, so try to get there well in advance. We plan on having a great group of students, faculty, and industry sponsors in attendance this semester. Three students will be assigned to each industry-sponsored team. Similar to last semester, the only food/refreshments provided will be snacks, soft drinks and water, through IEEE-Tech and the pro-shop. The entry fee to sponsor each team will be **\$175.00**. The deadline for withdrawing from the tournament is Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>. In the event that one of your teams is unable to participate for any reason after this date, half the entry fee for the team will be refunded. A full refund will be available if notification is received before the deadline.

An awards banquet will be held after the tournament at **Fuddrucker's**, located at the intersection of Harvey Road and George Bush Drive in College Station (please refer to the attached map for further directions). Prizes will be presented to the top teams, closest to the pin, and longest drive. This banquet will begin at **6:00pm** the evening of the golf tournament for all of those who attended the competition. Donations for door prizes and awards would be greatly appreciated.

Finally, the day after the tournament (Thursday), IEEE-Tech would like to invite each industry representative to join us for lunch at Fermier's courtyard to eat and gather with EET/TET students and faculty. We request as before, a donation of \$40 per attendee to cover luncheon expenses.
